History and Organization

The Idaho Environmental Summit is modeled after the Alaska Forum on the Environment, an event that welcomed over 1,400 people to its 9th gathering in Anchorage in 2007. Alaska Forum, Inc. gathers scientists, tribes, government representatives, community members, environmental organizations, industry, and others to share and learn information regarding environmental topics important to Alaskans.

In 2006, the Idaho Environmental Summit was launched using the Alaska Forum as a design template. With the leadership of the Nez Perce Tribe, support from a U.S. EPA grant and contributions of over 25 founding organizations, the first Idaho Environmental Summit drew over 330 participants in 2006. Participants represented over 135 organizations from more than 40 different cities.

In 2007, the Idaho Environmental Summit was established as an annual event to provide a venue for all the people and organizations of Idaho to promote effective communication, cooperation and education in regard to environmental topics.

The Idaho Environmental Summit is now sustained solely by supporting organizations and registration. Oversight is provided by a Steering and Planning Committee made of representatives from dozens of Idaho organizations and a Coordinator. The Idaho Environmental Summit receives operational support from the U.S. Forest Service, Rocky Mountain Research Station, the Nez Perce Tribe, Idaho Water Resources Research Institute and the Palouse-Clearwater Environmental Institute.
